SENATE FILE 2296 FISCAL NOTE

A fiscal note for Senate File 2296 is hereby submitted pursuant to Joint Rule 17. Data used in developing this fiscal note is available from the Legislative Fiscal Bureau to members of the Legislature upon request.

BACKCROUND

Senate File 2296 eliminates Chapter 192A, <u>Code of Iowa</u>, Marketing of Dairy Products, which is administered by the Department of Agriculture and Land Stewardship. The Department utilizes 1.00 FTE position for the administration of Chapter 192A. The cost of administering Chapter 192A is covered by permit fees paid by the producers of dairy products. According to Section 8.60, <u>Code of Iowa</u> the permit fees receipts are deposited into the Dairy Trade Practices account within the General fund for the sole purpose of administering Chapter 192A.

ASSUMPTIONS

Permit fees from dairy producers range from \$65,000 to \$80,000 annually. The cost to administer Chapter 192A ranges from \$45,000 to \$58,000 annually.

FISCAL IMPACT

Permit fees will no longer be collected or deposited in or expended from the Dairy Trade Practices account. There will be a FY 1999 ending balance of approximately \$250,000 in the Dairy Trade Practices account within the General Fund. Senate File 2296 does not address the disposition of the remaining account balance.
