- 32 EXPLANATION
- In 1999, the general assembly enacted House File 322 (1999
- 34 Iowa Acts, ch. 169) which provided for the production and
- 35 purchasing of agricultural commodities by regulating the

1 relationship between a contractor and a contract producer. A 2 contractor is a person who contracts with an agricultural 3 producer to produce a commodity on property held by the 4 agricultural producer. The agricultural producer is referred 5 to as a contract producer. The contract is referred to as a 6 production contract and commodity means crops, raw milk, and 7 livestock. This bill creates a new Code section which prohibits a 9 contractor from acting or attempting to act in a coercive or 10 retaliatory manner that restricts a contract producer from 11 associating with persons including communicating with other 12 agricultural producers or affiliating with agricultural 13 producer organizations. The bill provides that any provision 14 in a contract executed between a contract producer and a 15 contractor is void if the provision restricts a contract 16 producer from associating with such persons. 17 The bill also provides that a contractor who acts or 18 attempts to act in a coercive or retaliatory manner in 19 violation of the bill's prohibition is guilty of an aggravated 20 misdemeanor. An aggravated misdemeanor is punishable by 21 confinement for no more than two years and a fine of at least 22 \$500 but not more than \$5,000. 23 24 25 26 27 28 29 30 31 32 33
