A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to the establishment of a drug treatment facility
2 for offenders and a drug treatment facility advisory council
3 and providing a contingent effective date.
4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 901B.1, subsection 1, paragraph c, Code
- 2 1999, is amended by adding the following new subparagraph:
- 3 NEW SUBPARAGRAPH. (5) Drug treatment facility.
- 4 Sec. 2. Section 901B.1, subsection 4, paragraph a, Code
- 5 1999, is amended to read as follows:
- 6 a. The district department of correctional services shall
- 7 place an individual committed to it under section 907.3 to the
- 8 sanction and level of supervision which is appropriate to the
- 9 individual based upon a current risk assessment evaluation.
- 10 Placements may be to levels two and three of the corrections
- 11 continuum. The district department may, with the approval of
- 12 the department of corrections, place an individual in a level
- 13 three drug treatment facility established pursuant to section
- . 14 904.208, to assist the individual in complying with or to
 - 15 prevent the individual from violating conditions of probation.
- 16 The district department may, with the approval of the
- 17 department of corrections, place an individual in a level four
- 18 violator facility established pursuant to section 904.207 only
- 19 as a penalty for a violation of a condition imposed under this 20 section.
- 21 Sec. 3. NEW SECTION. 904.208 DRUG TREATMENT FACILITY.
- 22 1. The director shall establish and operate a facility for
- 23 the purpose of treating drug offenders who are under the
- 24 supervision of a judicial district department of correctional
- 25 services. The drug treatment facility shall provide
- 26 structured treatment to assist offenders in complying with or
- 27 to prevent offenders from violating conditions of probation
- 28 related to drug use.
- 29 2. A drug treatment facility advisory council is
- 30 established within the department to advise and make
- 31 recommendations to the director regarding the establishment
- 32 and operation of a facility for treating drug offenders and to
- 33 assist the implementation of treatment programs that are
- 34 proven to be effective for offenders. In addition to the
- 35 director, the drug treatment facility advisory council shall

- 1 consist of the directors of the eight judicial district
- 2 departments of correctional services and one representative
- 3 each from the judicial branch, the Iowa department of public
- 4 health, and a licensed substance abuse treatment program.
- 5 Upon the advice and recommendations of the director, the
- 6 board shall adopt rules pursuant to chapter 17A to establish
- 7 and administer the drug treatment facility.
- 8 Sec. 4. Section 908.11, subsection 6, paragraph c, Code
- 9 1999, is amended to read as follows:
- 10 c. Order the defendant to be placed in a violator facility
- 11 established pursuant to section 904.207 or 904.208 while
- 12 continuing the probation.
- 13 Sec. 5. CONTINGENT EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect
- 14 July 1, 2000, only if an appropriation funding the
- 15 establishment and operation of the drug treatment facility is
- 16 enacted.
- 17 EXPLANATION
- 18 This bill establishes a drug treatment facility in the 19 department of corrections.
- 20 The bill provides that an offender who is on probation and
- 21 who needs assistance to comply with conditions of probation,
- 22 or to prevent a violation of a condition of probation, may be
- 23 placed in the drug treatment facility by a judicial district
- 24 department of correctional services upon the approval of the
- 25 department of corrections for the purpose of drug treatment.
- 26 The bill establishes a drug offender advisory council
- 27 within the department of corrections to advise the director on
- 28 implementation of this bill and on effective treatment and
- 29 rehabilitation for offenders assigned to the new facility.
- 30 The members of the council shall consist of the director of
- 31 the department of corrections, the directors of the eight
- 32 judicial district departments of correctional services, and
- 33 one representative each from the judicial branch, the Iowa
- 34 department of public health, and a licensed substance abuse
- 35 treatment program.

5 facility.
      The bill takes effect July 1, 2000, but only if funding for
7 the establishment and operation of the facility is enacted.
