BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 279.7A, Code 1999, is amended to read as follows:

279.7A INTEREST IN PUBLIC CONTRACTS PROHIBITED --  
EXCEPTION.

A member of the board of directors of a school corporation shall not have an interest, direct or indirect, in a contract for the purchase of goods, including materials and profits, and the performance of services for the director's school corporation. A contract entered into in violation of this section is void. This section does not apply to contracts for the purchase of goods or services, which benefit a director, if the benefit to the director does not exceed one two
