APPROPRIATIONS

1 Section 1. DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY -- CRIME LAB.

2 There is appropriated from the general fund of the state to  
3 the department of public safety for the fiscal year beginning  
4 July 1, 2000, and ending June 30, 2001, the following amount,  
5 or so much thereof as is necessary, to be used for the purpose  
6 designated:

7 For the division of criminal investigation and bureau of  
8 identification, including the state's contribution to the  
9 peace officers' retirement, accident, and disability system  
10 provided in chapter 97A in the amount of 17 percent of the  
11 salaries for which the funds are appropriated, and to meet  
12 federal fund matching requirements, to be used for nine  
13 additional crime laboratory personnel:

14 ..... \$ 437,000

15 EXPLANATION

16 This bill appropriates money from the general fund to the  
17 department of public safety for the fiscal year beginning July  
18 1, 2000, for use by the division of criminal investigation and  
19 bureau of identification to hire nine additional crime  
20 laboratory personnel.
