1 Section 1. Section 7E.6, subsection 3, Code 1999, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 3. Any position of membership on the lottery board and the
4 Iowa economic development board shall receive compensation of
5 fifty dollars per day and expenses.

6 Sec. 2. Section 15.103, unnumbered paragraph 4, Code 1999,
7 is amended to read as follows:

8 Members of the board, the director, and other employees of
9 the department shall be allowed their actual and necessary
10 expenses incurred in the performance of their duties. All
11 expenses shall be paid from appropriations for those purposes
12 and the department is subject to the budget requirements of
13 chapter 8. Each member of the board ~~may-also-be-eligible-to~~
14 shall receive compensation as provided in section 7E.6,
15 subsection 3.

16 EXPLANATION

17 This bill provides that a member of the Iowa economic
18 development board shall receive compensation of \$50 per day
19 and expenses.

RE: IDED Board expenses and per diem.

Per Chapter 15 section 103, the Economic Development Board is allowed their actual and necessary expenses incurred in the performance of their duties. It also states that each member of the board may also be eligible to receive compensation as provided in section 7E.6. Section 7E.6 states that a per diem compensation at the rate of \$50 is also available but under circumstances listed in the section.

The purpose of the attached code change is to allow the members of the IDED board to receive a per diem for attending the monthly meetings as well as reimbursing them for their actual expenses. Because of the large volume of materials required for business applications, administrative rules, etc., the meetings take two days each month and can require considerable preparatory time.
