APPROPRIATIONS

1 Section 1. STATE BOARD OF REGENTS. There is appropriated
2 from the general fund of the state to the state board of
3 regents for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2000, and ending
4 June 30, 2001, the following amounts, or so much thereof as is
5 necessary, to be used for the purposes designated:

6 STATE UNIVERSITY OF IOWA

7 For the accredited school of public health and the
8 initiative for the health and independence of elderly Iowans:

9 \$ 2,750,000

10 IOWA STATE UNIVERSITY OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY

11 For the center for excellence in fundamental plant science,
12 and for salaries, support, maintenance, equipment, and
13 miscellaneous purposes:

14 \$ 4,670,000

15 UNIVERSITY OF NORTHERN IOWA

16 For continued implementation of the masters in social work
17 program and for not more than the following full-time
18 equivalent positions:

19 \$ 600,000

20 FTEs 6.00

21 EXPLANATION

22 This bill appropriates moneys to the state board of regents
23 from the general fund of the state for fiscal year 2000-2001
24 for purposes of providing a second year of funding for the
25 school of public health and the public health initiative at
26 the university of Iowa, the center for excellence in
27 fundamental plant science at Iowa state university, and the
28 masters in social work program at the university of northern
29 Iowa.
