A BILL FOR

1 An Act making an appropriation to the department of education for
2 pilot regional academies.
3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

APPROPRIATIONS

1 Section 1. DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION. There is appropriated
2 from the general fund of the state to the department of
3 education for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2000, and
4 ending June 30, 2001, the following amount, or so much thereof
5 as is necessary, to be used for the purpose designated:

6 For the establishment of pilot regional academies in
7 cooperation with school districts, area education agencies,
8 and postsecondary institutions:
9 \$ 300,000

10 Funds appropriated pursuant to this section shall be used
11 to award grant moneys to enable pilot regional academies to
12 provide high school students with advanced level courses and
13 technical courses not currently available within the
14 curriculum in their district of attendance. The department
15 shall submit a report on the status of the projects receiving
16 grants under this section to the senate and house standing
17 committees on education and the joint appropriations
18 subcommittee on education by December 1, 2000.

19 EXPLANATION

20 This bill appropriates moneys from the general fund of the
21 state to the department of education for fiscal year 2000-2001
22 for the establishment of pilot regional academies in
23 cooperation with school districts, area education agencies,
24 and postsecondary institutions. The moneys are to be issued
25 as grants to enable pilot regional academies to provide high
26 school students with advanced level courses and technical
27 courses unavailable in their school districts.

28 The department is instructed to submit a report on the
29 status of the grant projects to the general assembly's
30 education committees by December 1, 2000.
