14 teachers in the teaching profession, identify measurable
15 performance indicators and annually report results, and
16 demonstrate how the project can be self-supporting within a
17 three-year to five-year period. Notwithstanding section 8.33,
18 unencumbered or unobligated funds remaining on June 30 of the
19 fiscal year for which the funds were appropriated shall not
20 revert but shall be available for expenditure for the
21 following fiscal year for the purposes of this section.
