	30	fiscal year beginning July 1, 2000, and ending June 30, 2001,
	31	moneys appropriated by the general assembly from the general
	32	fund to the department of education for community colleges for
	33	a fiscal year shall be allocated to each community college by
	34	the department of education in the following manner:
	35	1. BASE FUNDING. The base funding for a fiscal year shall



- 1 be equal to the amount each community college received as an
- 2 allocation from appropriations made from the general fund of
- 3 the state in the most recent fiscal year.
- 4 2. DISTRIBUTION FOR INFLATION. First priority shall be to
- 5 give each college an increase based upon inflation. The
- 6 inflation increase shall be not less than 2 percent. However,
- 7 the inflation increase shall be equal to the national
- 8 inflation rate, if it exceeds 2 percent, if the amount of
- 9 state aid appropriated is equal to or greater than the
- 10 national inflation rate.
- 11 3. DISTRIBUTION BASED ON PROPORTIONAL SHARE OF ENROLLMENT.
- 12 The balance of the growth in state aid appropriations, once
- 13 the inflation increase has been satisfied, shall be
- 14 distributed based on each college's proportional share of
- 15 enrollment. However, a minimum of one percent of the total
- 16 growth shall be distributed in this manner.
- 4. If the total appropriation made by the general assembly
- 18 is less than 2 percent growth, the entire increase shall be
- 19 distributed as inflation.
- 20 EXPLANATION
- 21 The bill appropriates moneys from the general fund of the
- 22 state to the department of education for general state
- 23 financial aid to the community colleges for fiscal year 2000-
- 24 2001.
