From the funds appropriated in this subsection, the sum of $\$ 32,000$ shall be used to promote libraries as community centers for lifelong learning, encouraging reading and sharing of family stories with children early in life, and establishing nontraditional partnerships with libraries and community and business groups.

EXPLANATION
This bill makes an appropriation for fiscal year 2000-2001 from the general fund of the state to the state library for salaries, support, maintenance, and miscellaneous purposes, and provides that $\$ 32,000$ of the moneys appropriated must be used to promote libraries as community centers, encouraging reading and the sharing of family stories with children, and to establish nontraditional partnerships with libraries and
