1 Section 1. Section 99E.9, subsection 4, Code Supplement  
2 1999, is amended to read as follows:

3 4. The board and the commissioner may enter into written  
4 agreements or compacts with another state or states a  
5 territory of the United States, or one or more political  
6 subdivisions of another state or states territory of the  
7 United States, or any lottery operated outside the United  
8 States for the operation, marketing, and promotion of a joint  
9 lottery or joint lottery games. For the purposes of this  
10 subsection, any lottery with which the board and commissioner  
11 reach an agreement or compact shall meet the criteria for  
12 security, integrity, and finance set by the board.

13 EXPLANATION

14 This bill authorizes the Iowa lottery board and the  
15 commissioner of the lottery to enter into compacts or  
16 agreements with other states or territories of the United  
17 States, one or more political subdivisions of another state or  
18 territory of the United States, or a lottery operated outside  
19 of the United States. The compact or agreement shall meet the  
20 criteria of security, integrity, and finance set by the Iowa  
21 lottery board.
