NEW PARAGRAPH. c. If the amount of instructional support 3 4 state aid which a school district receives pursuant to 5 paragraph "a" or "b" is less than the amount which the 6 district would otherwise have received if the appropriation 7 had been an amount necessary to pay instructional support 8 state aid as determined under subsection 1, the school 9 district shall be eligible to increase the portion of its 10 instructional support budget that is local funding. The local 11 funding increase may be in an amount up to the level of 12 instructional support state aid which the school district 13 would have received if the appropriation had been an amount 14 necessary to pay instructional support state aid as determined 15 under subsection 1. To increase the amount of local funding 16 pursuant to this paragraph, a school district participating in 17 the instructional support program on the effective date of 18 this Act shall, pursuant to section 257.18, either adopt a 19 resolution to increase the amount of the local funding if the 20 remaining amount of the term does not exceed five years, or 21 submit the question for election if the remaining amount of 22 the term exceeds five years but does not exceed ten years. If 23 the question of increasing the amount of the local funding is 24 submitted for election, the question at election shall be 25 increasing the level of local funding from the existing level 26 up to the additional amount of local funding to be received 27 pursuant to this paragraph.

Section 1. Section 257.20, subsection 2, Code 1999, is amended by adding the following new paragraph:
