- 26 This bill provides for civil liability if an administrator
- 27 over a certain type of employee knew or was informed that the
- 28 individual committed sexual abuse of a child, as defined in
- 29 the bill, and failed to take appropriate action or took
- 30 appropriate action but failed to maintain adequate supervision
- 31 of the individual. New Code section 232.74A applies to a
- 32 person, official, agency, or institution with supervisory or
- 33 other administrative responsibilities over an individual who
- 34 is a member of the clergy or an adult with duties involving
- 35 access to a child when the child is alone. The sexual abuse

1 crimes addressed by the bill include sexual abuse under Code 2 chapter 709, incest, involvement in prostitution, and sexual 3 exploitation of a minor.
