**A BILL FOR**

1 An Act providing for the operational location of the drug  
2 enforcement and abuse prevention coordinator and the  
3 governor's alliance on substance abuse.

SF 372 STATE GOVERNMENT

1 Section 1. Section 80E.1, subsection 1, Code 1999, is  
2 amended to read as follows:

3 1. A The position of drug enforcement and abuse prevention  
4 coordinator is established within the department of public  
5 safety. The drug enforcement and abuse prevention coordinator  
6 shall be appointed by the governor, subject to confirmation by  
7 the senate, and shall serve at the pleasure of the governor.  
8 The governor shall fill a vacancy in the office in the same  
9 manner as the original appointment was made. The coordinator  
10 shall be selected primarily for administrative ability. The  
11 coordinator shall not be selected on the basis of political  
12 affiliation and shall not engage in political activity while  
13 holding the office. The salary of the coordinator shall be  
14 fixed by the governor.

15 Sec. 2. Section 80E.1, subsection 2, paragraph a, Code  
16 1999, is amended to read as follows:

17 a. Coordinate and monitor all statewide narcotics  
18 enforcement efforts, operate and supervise the governor's  
19 alliance on substance abuse, coordinate and monitor all state  
20 and federal substance abuse treatment grants and programs,  
21 coordinate and monitor all statewide substance abuse  
22 prevention and education programs in communities and schools,  
23 and engage in such other related activities as required by  
24 law. The coordinator shall work in coordinating the efforts  
25 of the department of corrections, the department of education,  
26 the Iowa department of public health, the department of public  
27 safety, and the department of human services. The coordinator  
28 shall assist in the development and implementation of local  
29 and community strategies to fight substance abuse, including  
30 local law enforcement, education, and treatment activities.

31 EXPLANATION

32 This bill provides that the position of drug enforcement  
33 and abuse prevention coordinator is established within the  
34 department of public safety. The bill also codifies the  
35 requirement, established in 1989 Iowa Acts, chapter 225,

1 section 5, that the coordinator is responsible for the  
2 operation of the governor's alliance on substance abuse.
