A BILL FOR

1 An Act establishing the community economic betterment  
2 recreational and cultural program and community economic  
3 betterment recreational and cultural program account.  
4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

APPROPRIATIONS

1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. 15.321 COMMUNITY ECONOMIC  
2 BETTERMENT RECREATIONAL AND CULTURAL PROGRAM.

3 The purpose of the community economic betterment  
4 recreational and cultural program is to assist communities in  
5 the development and creation of multipurpose recreational and  
6 cultural facilities. All provisions of section 15.317 shall  
7 apply to this program. The department shall use the rating  
8 factors and criteria in section 15.318 to develop applicable  
9 rating factors and criteria for the program with the addition  
10 of rating factors and criteria relating to tourism potential  
11 and the economic impact of the facility being considered.

12 Sec. 2. NEW SECTION. 15.322 COMMUNITY ECONOMIC  
13 BETTERMENT RECREATIONAL AND CULTURAL PROGRAM ACCOUNT.

14 1. A community economic betterment recreational and  
15 cultural program account is established within the strategic  
16 investment fund to be used by the department for the community  
17 economic betterment recreational and cultural program. The  
18 account shall consist of all appropriations, grants, or gifts  
19 received by the department specifically for use under section  
20 15.321 and any moneys allocated to the community economic  
21 betterment recreational and cultural program account from the  
22 strategic investment fund.

23 2. Payments of interest, repayments of moneys loaned under  
24 the community economic betterment recreational and cultural  
25 program, or recaptures of awards shall be deposited into the  
26 strategic investment fund.

27 EXPLANATION

28 This bill establishes a community economic betterment  
29 recreational and cultural program to assist communities in the  
30 development and creation of multipurpose recreational and  
31 cultural facilities. The community economic betterment  
32 program requirements relating to types of assistance, entities  
33 that may apply for assistance, limitations on the amount of  
34 assistance, and the amount of time during which an entity must  
35 utilize the assistance apply to the community economic

1 betterment recreational and cultural program. The ratings  
2 factors and criteria of the community economic betterment  
3 program also apply to the community economic betterment  
4 recreational and cultural program with the addition of ratings  
5 factors and criteria relating to tourism potential and  
6 economic impact of the facility being considered.

7 The bill establishes a community economic betterment  
8 recreational and cultural program account within the strategic  
9 investment fund. The bill provides that payments of interest,  
10 repayments of moneys loaned under the community economic  
11 betterment recreational and cultural program, or recaptures of  
12 awards shall be deposited into the strategic investment fund.

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
