- 1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. 613.20 LIMITATION OF LIABILITY
- 2 IN CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTS.
- 3 1. For purposes of this section:
- 4 a. "Limitation or elimination of tort liability" includes,
- 5 but is not limited to, an indemnification agreement.
- 6 b. "Major repair" means a construction, reconstruction,
- 7 demolition, or remodeling project with a value greater than
- 8 twenty-five percent of the estimated value of the structure
- 9 affected by the project.
- 10 2. An agreement for limitation or elimination of tort
- 11 liability in or related to a contract or agreement pertaining
- 12 to the construction, reconstruction, demolition, remodeling,
- 13 improvement, maintenance, or major repair of all or part of a
- 14 structure is void and unenforceable.
- 15 3. This section does not apply to the following:
- 16 a. An insurance contract, construction bond, workers'
- 17 compensation plan, or similar agreement lawfully issued by an
- 18 insurer or bonding company.
- 19 b. An offer to compromise disputed claims or an agreement
- 20 to settle existing or potential litigation claims.
- 21 c. A contract for or a clause in a contract requiring
- 22 arbitration or mediation of disputed claims.
- 23 d. A valid liquidated damages provision.
- 24 e. Limitation of liability established pursuant to
- 25 statute.
- 26 f. A limitation of liability negotiated between an owner
- 27 or occupant of real property and a design professional
- 28 licensed in Iowa.
- 29 EXPLANATION
- 30 This bill creates a new Code section providing that
- 31 limitations of liability, including but not limited to
- 32 indemnification provisions, related to certain construction
- 33 contracts are void and unenforceable. The section includes
- 34 definitions, as well as specifically excludes from its scope
- 35 certain insurance contracts, settlement agreements,
