22 EXPLANATION

23 This bill amends Code chapter 184 which establishes the
24 Iowa egg council. The bill eliminates a number of
25 requirements relating to the administration of the council.
26 It eliminates a provision prohibiting a member of the council
27 from serving more than two complete consecutive terms. It
28 eliminates a requirement that the chairperson or other officer
29 of the council must be a voting member and must serve a one-
30 year term. It also eliminates a requirement that prohibits a
31 member of the council from being a salaried employee of an
32 organization or agency receiving moneys from the council.

21 NEW SUBSECTION. 6. Become a dues-paying member of an
22 organization carrying out a purpose related to the increased
23 consumption and utilization of eggs or egg products.

24 NEW SUBSECTION. 7. Fund research and education programs
25 directed toward better and more efficient production,
26 marketing, and utilization of eggs and egg products.

27 Sec. 4. Section 184.11, subsections 1 and 2, Code 1999,
28 are amended by striking the subsections.

29 Sec. 5. Section 184.11, subsections 3 and 4, Code 1999,
30 are amended by striking the subsections and inserting in lieu
31 thereof the following:

32 3. Execute a contract or act as an agent of a person who
33 executes a contract for any of the following:

34 a. Selling eggs or egg products.

35 b. Selling equipment used in the manufacturing of egg

19 Sec. 8. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act, being deemed of
20 immediate importance, takes effect upon enactment.

21 EXPLANATION

22 This bill amends Code chapter 184 which establishes the
23 Iowa egg council. The bill eliminates a number of
24 requirements relating to the administration of the council.
25 It eliminates a provision prohibiting a member of the council
26 from serving more than two complete consecutive terms. It
27 eliminates a requirement that the chairperson or other officer
28 of the council must serve a one-year term. It provides for
29 the powers and duties of the council, including by becoming a
30 member of organizations and funding research and education
31 programs. It rewrites a provision prohibiting the council
32 selling eggs or egg machinery. It eliminates a requirement
33 that prohibits a member of the council from being a salaried
34 employee of an organization or agency receiving moneys from
35 the council. It eliminates a provision providing that council

1 expenses and bond premiums must be paid from assessments.
