SF 62 STATE GOVERNMENT

1 Section 1. Section 56.42, subsection 2, Code 1999, is  
2 amended to read as follows:

3 2. a. If an unexpended balance of campaign funds remains  
4 in the committee's account when a candidate's committee  
5 dissolves, the unexpended balance shall be transferred  
6 pursuant to subsection 1.

7 b. If an unexpended balance of campaign funds remains in  
8 the account of a candidate's committee for at least seven  
9 years after the candidate's last day of service in a public  
10 office, the unexpended balance shall be transferred pursuant  
11 to subsection 1, paragraph "b".

12 EXPLANATION

13 This bill amends Code section 56.42 to permit a transfer of  
14 funds remaining in a candidate's account to a national, state,  
15 or local political party, or congressional campaign, after the  
16 candidate has not served in public office for seven years.
