- 1 Section 1. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. 514C.14 MENTAL HEALTH AND
- 2 SUBSTANCE ABUSE TREATMENT COVERAGE.
- 3 l. a. Notwithstanding section 514C.6, a policy or
- 4 contract providing for third-party payment or prepayment of
- 5 health or medical expenses shall provide coverage benefits for
- 6 mental health and substance abuse conditions based on rates,
- 7 terms, and conditions which are no more restrictive than the
