SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 109

A Senate Resolution urging the Democratic and Republican parties of Iowa to use presidential preference cards in the presidential caucuses.

WHEREAS, the Iowa presidential caucuses are an integral part of the national presidential selection process; and

WHEREAS, the importance of the Iowa caucuses in the presidential selection process demands high participation in the caucuses by Iowa voters; and

WHEREAS, allowing use of a presidential preference card at the Iowa caucuses would greatly increase participation in the caucuses; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE, That the Democratic and Republican parties of Iowa change their caucus rules to allow implementation of the use of presidential preference cards at the caucuses upon application by the voter; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That, upon adoption, an official copy of this Resolution be delivered to the Chairperson of the Iowa Republican Party, the Chairperson of the Iowa Democratic Party, and the Iowa Secretary of State.
