

HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 117

(COMPANION TO LSB 6205SS BY LUNDBY)

A Concurrent Resolution requesting the legislative council to authorize the personal privacy issues study committee to continue deliberations during the 2002 legislative interim.

WHEREAS, the personal privacy issues study committee created for the 2000 interim was charged to review the privacy protections in Iowa law for Iowa consumers with the primary focus of the review to be on the area of confidentiality of financial records and to also include a focus on medical records with an emphasis on protections for the potential abuse in the gathering and dissemination of genetic testing information; and

WHEREAS, the study committee was also authorized to explore other areas regarding privacy records as deemed fit by the study committee membership; and

WHEREAS, the study committee held an initial two-day meeting, and reviewed materials and testimony regarding internet privacy and security, IowAccess and privacy concerns, worker privacy issues, motor vehicle driver's license information, educational records, public records, financial records, and medical records; and

WHEREAS, because there are other issues and additional information regarding the items initially reviewed that committee members believe should be considered and the legislative council agreed to

7 2002 legislative interim and to make a report to the
8 Eightieth General Assembly, 2003 Session, for its
