1 Section 1. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. 455B.207 CONTRACTORS SUBJECT TO 2 CIVIL PENALTIES.

3 1. As used in this section, all of the following apply: 4 a. "Contract confinement feeding operation" or "operation" 5 means a confinement feeding operation in which animals owned 6 or controlled by a contractor are produced by a contract 7 producer pursuant to a production contract.

8 b. "Contract producer" means a person who holds a legal 9 interest in a contract confinement feeding operation and who 10 produces animals owned or controlled by a contractor and kept 11 at the contract producer's operation.

12 c. "Contractor" means a person who owns or controls 13 animals that are produced by a contract producer at the 14 contract producer's contract confinement feeding operation 15 pursuant to a production contract.

16 d. "Produce" means to provide care and feed to animals 17 kept in a confinement feeding operation.

e. "Production contract" means an oral or written
agreement executed by a contractor and another party who may
be the contract producer, if all of the following apply:
(1) The agreement provides for the production of animals
owned or controlled by the contractor.

(2) A contract producer carries out the production at the
 24 contract producer's operation according to the terms of an
 25 agreement.

26 2. For purposes of this section, all of the following27 apply:

28 a. A person is a contractor if all of the following 29 applies:

30 (1) The person executes a production contract with a 31 contract producer or another party for the production of 32 animals owned or controlled by the person.

33 (2) A contract producer carries out the production of the
 34 animals pursuant to a production contract executed by the
 35 contract producer, regardless of whether the person is a party

1 to that production contract.

2 b. A contractor owns or controls animals if the contractor3 does any of the following:

4 (1) Owns a legal interest in the animals.

5 (2) Holds the right to purchase or sell the animals.

6 3. a. If a contract producer violates a provision of this 7 part, the contractor who owns or controls animals kept in the 8 contract producer's operation where the violation occurs shall 9 be deemed to have violated the same provision.

b. The contractor shall be subject to classification as a
habitual violator in the manner provided in section 455B.191.
c. The department or a court is not required to impose the
same penalty upon a contractor as the penalty imposed upon the
contract producer who commits a violation described in this
section.

16 4. This section does not apply to a contractor if the 17 total animal weight capacity of all animals owned or 18 controlled by the contractor in this state at the time of the 19 violation is two hundred thousand pounds or less for animals 20 other than bovine, or four hundred thousand pounds or less for 21 bovine.

EXPLANATION

This bill amends Code chapter 455B which in part regulates animal feeding operations, including confinement feeding operations.

The bill provides that a person who owns or controls animals kept in a confinement feeding operation under contract is deemed to have committed a violation of provisions pregulating water quality to the same extent as a contract producer who owns the confinement feeding operation. The bill provides that a person is a contractor if the person executes a production contract with a contract producer or another a party for the production of animals owned by the person and a contract producer carries out the production, regardless of whether the person is a party to a contract with the producer.

1 The contractor is subject to classification as a habitual 2 violator as if the contractor were a contract producer. The 3 bill provides that the department or a court is not required 4 to impose the same penalty upon a contractor as the penalty 5 imposed on the contract producer who commits the violation. 6 The provision does not apply to a contractor, if the total 7 animal weight capacity of all animals owned or controlled by 8 the contractor is 200,000 pounds or less for animals other 9 than bovine, or 400,000 pounds or less for bovine. A person who violates the part of the chapter regulating 10 11 water quality is, according to Code section 455B.191, subject 12 to a civil penalty of not more than \$5,000.
