## A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to the apportionment of local option sales and
2 services tax for school infrastructure election costs, and
3 providing an effective date.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 422E.2, subsection 4, paragraph b, unnumbered paragraph 1, Code 2001, is amended to read as follows:

Within ten days of the election at which a majority of those voting on the question favors the imposition, repeal, or 6 change in the rate of the tax, the county auditor shall give 7 written notice by sending a copy of the abstract of the votes

8 from the favorable election to the director of revenue and

9 finance of the result of the election. Election costs shall

10 be apportioned among school districts within the county on a

11 pro rata basis in proportion to the number of registered

12 voters in each school district who reside in the county and

13 the total number of registered voters in all of the school

14 districts within the county who reside in the county.

15 Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act, being deemed of

16 immediate importance, takes effect upon enactment.

17 EXPLANATION

This bill provides that election costs incurred as a result 19 of an election to impose the local option sales and services 20 tax for school infrastructure will be apportioned among school

21 districts within a county based on a pro rata allocation

22 determined with regard to registered voters residing in the

23 county. Currently, election costs are apportioned among

24 school districts within a county based upon the proportion of

25 the number of registered voters in each school district and

26 the total number of registered voters in all the school

27 districts within the county. The bill restricts the

28 proportion to those registered voters actually residing in the

29 county. A registered voter in a school district residing in a

30 portion of the school district located outside the county in

31 which the election takes place will therefore not be included

32 in determining election costs allocation.

33 The bill takes effect upon enactment.

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
