- 1 Section 1. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. 321.363A CELLULAR TELEPHONE USE 2 BY MINORS WHILE DRIVING.
- Except as provided in this section, a person operating
- 4 a motor vehicle pursuant to an instruction permit or
- 5 intermediate driver's license issued under section 321.180B
- 6 shall not use a cellular telephone while the motor vehicle is
- 7 in operation.
- 8 2. The use of a cellular telephone by an operator of a
- 9 motor vehicle is not a violation of this section if the
- 10 operator uses the cellular telephone to call a 911 or other
- 11 emergency number.
- 12 3. For purposes of this section, "cellular telephone"
- 13 means a radio-link telephone that provides dial tone access to
- 14 a portable, mobile, or fixed location for which a charge is
- 15 levied.
- 16 EXPLANATION
- 17 This bill creates a new criminal offense for the use of a
- 18 cellular telephone by a minor operating a motor vehicle
- 19 pursuant to an instruction permit or intermediate driver's
- 20 license, unless the call is for emergency purposes.
- 21 A person who violates this bill commits a simple
- 22 misdemeanor under Code chapter 321 punishable by confinement
- 23 for no more than 30 days or a fine of at least \$50 but not
- 24 more than \$500 or by both.
