Section 1. RESIDENT ADVOCATE COORDINATORS. There is appropriated from the general fund of the state to the department of elder affairs for the fiscal year beginning July

Funds appropriated in this section shall be disbursed by the director of the department of elder affairs over a twoyear period to assist resident advocate coordinators employed through area agencies on aging in providing training and assistance to volunteer members of resident advocate committees.

## EXPLANATION

This bill appropriates from the general fund of the state to the department of elder affairs for the fiscal year beginning July l, 2001, and ending June 30, 2002, $\$ 90,000$. The bill provides that the funds shall be disbursed by the director of the department of elder affairs over a two-year period to assist resident advocate coordinators employed through area agencies on aging in providing training and assistance to volunteer members of resident advocate committees.
