1 Section 1. Section 8.57, Code 2001, is amended by adding 2 the following new subsection:

3 <u>NEW SUBSECTION</u>. 6. a. A volunteer fire fighters and 4 emergency responders fund is created under the authority of 5 the department of management. The fund shall consist of 6 appropriations made to the fund and transfers of interest, 7 earnings, and moneys from other funds as provided by law. The 8 fund shall be separate from the general fund of the state and 9 the balance in the fund shall not be considered part of the 10 balance of the general fund of the state. However, the fund 11 shall be considered a special account for the purposes of 12 section 8.53, relating to generally accepted accounting 13 principles.

b. Moneys in the volunteer fire fighters and emergency
responders fund are not subject to section 8.33.
Notwithstanding section 12C.7, subsection 2, interest or
earnings on moneys in the fund shall be credited to the fund.
c. Moneys in the volunteer fire fighters and emergency
responders fund in a fiscal year shall be used for all of the
following:

21 (1) To provide pensions for qualified volunteer fire22 fighters and volunteer emergency response personnel.

23 (2) To offset the costs of an income tax credit or
24 deduction for volunteer fire fighters and volunteer emergency
25 response personnel.

26 (3) To provide training and equipment to local volunteer27 fire departments and volunteer emergency responders.

The state fire service and emergency response council shall prepare a plan for expenditure of the moneys deposited in the Moneys in the fund are subject to appropriation by the general assembly.

32 d. For the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2002, and for 33 each fiscal year thereafter, not more than the amount of 34 premium tax receipts collected pursuant to section 432.1, 35 subsection 2, in the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2001, shall

1 be deposited in the general fund of the state. The total 2 premium tax receipt moneys in excess of the moneys deposited 3 in the general fund of the state in a fiscal year shall be 4 deposited in the volunteer fire fighters and emergency 5 responders fund and shall be used as provided in this 6 subsection.

7 Sec. 2. Section 8.58, Code 2001, is amended to read as 8 follows:

9 8.58 EXEMPTION FROM AUTOMATIC APPLICATION.

10 To the extent that moneys appropriated under section 8.57 11 do not result in moneys being credited to the general fund 12 under section 8.55, subsection 2, moneys appropriated under 13 section 8.57 and moneys contained in the cash reserve fund, 14 rebuild Iowa infrastructure fund, environment first fund, 15 <u>volunteer fire fighters and emergency responders fund</u>, and 16 Iowa economic emergency fund shall not be considered in the 17 application of any formula, index, or other statutory 18 triggering mechanism which would affect appropriations, 19 payments, or taxation rates, contrary provisions of the Code 20 notwithstanding.

To the extent that moneys appropriated under section 8.57 22 do not result in moneys being credited to the general fund 23 under section 8.55, subsection 2, moneys appropriated under 24 section 8.57 and moneys contained in the cash reserve fund, 25 rebuild Iowa infrastructure fund, environment first fund, 26 <u>volunteer fire fighters and emergency responders fund</u>, and 27 Iowa economic emergency fund shall not be considered by an 28 arbitrator or in negotiations under chapter 20.

29 Sec. 3. Section 100B.2, Code 2001, is amended by adding 30 the following new subsection:

31 <u>NEW SUBSECTION</u>. 9. Prepare a plan for expenditure of 32 moneys from the volunteer fire fighter and emergency 33 responders fund created in section 8.57.

35 This bill creates a volunteer fire fighters and emergency

1 responders fund. The bill provides that, beginning with the 2 fiscal year beginning July 1, 2002, deposits into the fund 3 will be collected from premium tax receipts on insurance 4 policies, other than life insurance policies, in excess of the 5 revenues collected for that tax in the fiscal year beginning 6 July 1, 2001.

7 Moneys in the fund are subject to appropriation by the 8 general assembly and are to be used for establishing a pension 9 system for volunteer fire fighters and emergency response 10 personnel, offsetting an income tax credit or deduction for 11 volunteer fire fighters and emergency response personnel, and 12 providing training and equipment to local volunteer fire 13 departments and volunteer emergency responders. The fire 14 service and emergency response council in the department of 15 public safety is responsible for developing a plan for 16 expenditure of moneys in the fund.
