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Section 1. NEW SECTION. 514C.13A GROUP MANAGED CARE 1 2 HEALTH PLANS -- PROHIBITION OF CERTAIN FINANCIAL INCENTIVES 3 FOR HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS. 1. A managed care health plan, as defined in section 5 514C.13, shall not contain any provision in a contract with 6 any health care provider, as defined in section 514C.13, that, 7 as its predominant purpose, creates direct financial 8 incentives for the health care provider to withhold medically 9 necessary, covered health care services. 10 This section shall not be construed to prohibit a 11 contract between a health care provider and a managed care 12 health plan that contains financial incentives for efficient 13 management of the utilization and cost of covered health care 14 services. 15 **EXPLANATION** 16 This bill creates new Code section 514C.13A, to prohibit 17 provisions in a contract between a managed care health plan 18 and a health care provider that have a predominant purpose of 19 creating direct financial incentives for the health care 20 provider to withhold medically necessary, covered health care 21 services. The new Code section specifically states that the 22 23 prohibition against such clauses does not extend to financial 24 incentives for efficient management of the utilization and 25 cost of covered health care services. 26 27 28 29 30 31
