## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act prohibiting certain acts associated with telemarketing
  2 sales calls and making a civil penalty applicable.
  3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. 476.58 RESTRICTIONS ON USE OF
- 2 EQUIPMENT USED TO DIAL MULTIPLE TELEPHONE NUMBERS.
- 3 l. For purposes of this section, unless the context
- 4 otherwise requires:
- 5 a. "ADAD equipment" means ADAD equipment as defined in
- 6 section 476.57.
- 7 b. "Telemarketer" means a person who makes telephonic
- 8 sales calls.
- 9 c. "Telephonic sales call" means a call made by a
- 10 telemarketer to a consumer for any of the following purposes:
- 11 (1) To solicit a sale of a consumer good or service.
- 12 (2) To solicit an extension of credit for a consumer good
- 13 or service.
- 14 (3) To obtain information that will or may be used for the
- 15 direct solicitation of a sale of a consumer good or service or
- 16 an extension of credit for such purpose.
- 17 2. A telemarketer shall not use ADAD equipment or any
- 18 similar equipment to make telephonic sales calls where the
- 19 number of live telemarketers is less than the number of
- 20 telephonic sales calls dialed by such equipment, and where the
- 21 number of telemarketers would be insufficient to engage in
- 22 each of the telephonic sales calls, if all calls made by such
- 23 equipment resulted in a completed call to each of the
- 24 telephone numbers dialed.
- 25 3. A person who violates subsection 2 is subject to a
- 26 civil penalty in the same manner as provided in section 476.51
- 27 with regard to a public utility.
- 28 EXPLANATION
- 29 This bill provides that a telemarketer shall not use ADAD
- 30 equipment or any similar equipment to make telephonic sales
- 31 calls where the number of live telemarketers is less than the
- 32 number of telephonic sales calls dialed by that equipment, and
- 33 where the number of telemarketers would be insufficient to
- 34 engage in the telephonic sales calls if all calls made by that
- 35 equipment result in a completed call to the numbers dialed.
