1 Section 1. Section 298.3, subsection 3, Code 2001, is 2 amended to read as follows:

3 3. The purchase of buildings and the purchase of a single
4 unit of <u>non-technology-related</u> equipment or-a-technology
5 system exceeding one thousand five hundred dollars in value.
6 For the purposes of this subsection, "non-technology-related
7 equipment" means equipment other than that meeting the
8 definition of technology pursuant to subsection 3A.

9 Sec. 2. Section 298.3, Code 2001, is amended by adding the 10 following new subsection:

11 <u>NEW SUBSECTION</u>. 3A. Technology expenditures. For the 12 purposes of this subsection, "technology" means hardwar and 13 software, and materials and supplies related to instruc ion 1 14 technology.

EXPLANATION

16 This bill provides for the utilization of physical plant 17 and equipment levy revenue for technology expenditures. The 18 bill modifies the provision contained in Code Bection 298.3, 19 subsection 3, authorizing the expenditure of physical plant 20 and equipment levy revenue for a single unit of equipment or a 21 technology system exceeding \$1,500 in value, such that the 22 dollar limitation shall apply only to the procurement of 23 equipment which does not constitute technology as defined in 24 the bill. The bill provides that revenue may be expended for 25 technology purposes without dollar limitation. The bill 26 provides that "technology" is defined as hardware and 27 software, and materials and supplies related to instructional 28 technology.
