1 Section 1. Section 331.904, subsection 1, Code 2001, is
2 amended by striking the subsection and inserting in lieu
3 thereof the following:

4 1. The annual salary of the first and second deputy
5 officer, and if more than two deputies are required, each
6 additional deputy of the office of auditor, treasurer, and
7 recorder, and the deputy in charge of the motor vehicle
8 registration and title division, shall be determined by the
9 board of supervisors which may consider the recommendation of
10 the deputy's principal officer. The board of supervisors
11 shall certify the annual salaries of the deputy officers to
12 the auditor.

13 **EXPLANATION**

14 This bill removes the statutory salary limitations on the
15 annual salaries of the deputy officers in the offices of
16 county auditor, treasurer, and recorder. Each deputy
17 officer's annual salary will be determined by the board of
18 supervisors which may consider the recommendation of the
19 deputy's principal officer. The board of supervisors shall
20 certify the annual salaries of the deputy officers to the
21 auditor.
