Section 1. Section 331.904, subsection 1, Code 2001, is amended by striking the subsection and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

I. The annual salary of the first and second deputy officer, and if more than two deputies are required, each additional deputy of the office of auditor, treasurer, and recorder, and the deputy in charge of the motor vehicle registration and title division, shall be determined by the board of supervisors which may consider the recommendation of the deputy's principal officer. The board of supervisors shall certify the annual salaries of the deputy officers to the auditor.

EXPLANATION

This bill removes the statutory salary limitations on the sannual salaries of the deputy officers in the offices of county auditor, treasurer, and recorder. Each deputy officer's annual salary will be determined by the board of supervisors which may consider the recommendation of the geputy's principal officer. The board of supervisors shall certify the annual salaries of the deputy officers to the auditor.
