Section 1. Section 35A.12, Code Supplement 2001, is amended to read as follows:

35A.12 MILITARY VETERANS HONOR GUARD SERVICES.

An honor guard unit made up of members of a recognized military veterans organization as listed in section 35A.2 or 37.2, the Iowa national guard, the reserve forces of the
