Description

House File 2152 eliminates the repeal of a \$100,000 death benefit for emergency services providers not covered by the Public Safety Peace Officers' Retirement, Accident, and Disability System, the Iowa Public Employees' Retirement System (IPERS), or the Municipal Fire and Police Retirement System of Iowa, who die in the line of duty.

Assumptions

- The number of deaths that will occur is unknown.
- During calendar years 1994 through 2000, a total of four Iowa volunteer fire fighters died in the line of duty.

Fiscal Impact

The fiscal impact of HF 5152 cannot be determined since the number of future deaths cannot be determined.

Each death of an emergency services provider, not covered by the Public Safety Peace Officers' Retirement, Accident, and Disability System, the Iowa Public Employees' Retirement System (IPERS), or the Municipal Fire and Police Retirement System of Iowa, in the line of duty, beginning July 1, 2002, would result in a \$100,000 impact to the General Fund.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 100B.11, subsection 3, Code 2001, is amended to read as follows:

3. For purposes of this section, "volunteer emergency services provider" means a volunteer fire fighter as defined in section 85.61, or a volunteer emergency medical care provider or volunteer emergency rescue technician defined in section 147A.1 who is not covered as a volunteer emergency services provider under chapter 97A, 97B, or 411, or a reserve peace officer as defined in section 80D.1A.

Sec. 2. 2000 Iowa Acts, chapter 1232, section 98, is repealed.
