2 2001, is amended to read as follows:

3 The board of trustees shall be vested with authority to 4 provide-for-the-management manage, control, govern, and 5 government exercise ownership of the operations and real 6 estate of the city hospital or health care facility 7 established as permitted by this section, and shall provide 8 all needed rules for the economic conduct thereof and shall 9 annually prepare a condensed statement of the total receipts 10 and expenditures for the hospital or health care facility and 11 cause the same to be published in a newspaper of general 12 circulation in the city in which the hospital or health care 13 facility is located. In the management of the hospital or 14 health care facility no discrimination shall be made against 15 practitioners of any school of medicine recognized by the laws 16 of the state.
