1 An Act relating to establishing a presumption that cancer and infectious diseases are work-related for purposes of disability and death benefits under public retirement systems covering public safety employees. 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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      This bill provides that infectious diseases or cancer
 2 contracted by certain members of public retirement systems in
 3 Iowa are presumed to be diseases contracted while on active
 4 duty due to the job for purposes of establishing disability or
 5 providing a death benefit. The persons to which this bill
 6 applies are members of the public safety peace officers'
 7 retirement system (PORS), members of the statewide fire and
 8 police retirement system (MFRSI), and special service members
 9 of the Iowa public employees' retirement system (IPERS).
10 bill also provides that the presumption will not apply to
11 members who joined the system on or after July 1, 1992, for
12 members of PORS and MFRSI, or on or after July 1, 2000, for
13 special service members of IPERS, and in which the infectious
14 disease or cancer would not have existed but for a medical
15 condition that was known on the date the member joined.

18 section 25B.2, however, does not apply to public employee
19 retirement systems.
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
