11 occupational-disease,-after-the-last-injurious-exposure-to
12 such-disease-in-such-employment,-or-in-case-of-death,-unless

15 compensation-has-been-paid-or-awarded-or-timely-claim-made-as

      This bill eliminates the requirement that compensation for
20 occupational disease is payable only if compensable
21 disablement or death occurs within a certain period of time
22 after the last workplace exposure to the cause of the disease.
