Section 1. Section 351.39, Code 2001, is amended to read
as follows:

3 351.39 CONFINEMENT.

When <u>If</u> a local board of health receives information that any-person-has-been-bitten-by an animal <u>has bitten a person</u> or that a dog or animal is suspected of having rabies, it <u>the</u> <u>board</u> shall order the owner to confine such animal in the manner it directs. If the owner fails to confine such animal in the manner directed, the animal shall be apprehended and impounded by such board, and after two weeks the board may humanely destroy the animal. If such animal is returned to its owner, the owner shall pay the cost of impoundment. <u>This</u> <u>section shall not apply to a police service dog as defined in</u> 14 section 717B.9.
