## A BILL FOR

1 An Act creating an early childhood programs endowment fund. 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA: 3

Section 1. Section 8.54, subsection 1, unnumbered 2 paragraph 1, Code Supplement 2001, is amended to read as 3 follows:

4 For the purposes of section 8.22A, this section, and 5 sections 8.55 through  $\theta$ -57 <u>8.57B</u>:

6 Sec. 2. Section 8.54, subsection 5, Code Supplement 2001,7 is amended by striking the subsection.

8 Sec. 3. Section 8.55, subsection 2, Code Supplement 2001,9 is amended to read as follows:

2. The maximum balance of the fund is the amount equal to
11 five percent of the adjusted revenue estimate for the fiscal
12 year. If the amount of moneys in the Iowa economic emergency
13 fund is equal to the maximum balance, moneys in excess of this
14 amount shall be transferred to the general-fund early
15 childhood programs endowment fund created in section 8.57B.
16 Sec. 4. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. 8.57B EARLY CHILDHOOD PROGRAMS
17 ENDOWMENT FUND.

18 1. The early childhood programs endowment fund is created. 19 The fund shall be separate from the general fund of the state 20 and the balance in the fund shall not be considered part of 21 the balance of the general fund of the state. Notwithstanding 22 section 12C.7, subsection 2, interest or earnings on moneys 23 deposited in the fund shall be credited to the fund. The 24 moneys credited to the fund are not subject to section 8.33 25 and shall not be transferred, used, obligated, appropriated, 26 or otherwise encumbered except as provided in this section. 27 2. a. Except as provided in paragraph "b", the interest 28 and earnings on moneys in the early childhood programs 29 endowment fund shall only be used pursuant to an annual 30 appropriation made by the general assembly for purposes of 31 enhancing preschool and early education programs for young 32 children and their families. Otherwise, moneys credited to 33 the early childhood programs endowment fund are not subject to 34 appropriation unless the bill or joint resolution making the 35 appropriation complies with all of the following requirements:

1 (1) The appropriation is contained in a bill or joint 2 resolution in which the appropriation is the only subject 3 matter of the bill or joint resolution.

4 (2) The bill or joint resolution states the reasons the 5 appropriation is necessary.

6 (3) The bill or joint resolution is approved by vote of at 7 least three-fifths of the members of both chambers of the 8 general assembly and is signed by the governor.

9 b. Moneys in the fund may be used for cash flow purposes 10 during a fiscal year provided that any moneys so allocated are 11 returned to the fund by the end of that fiscal year.

12 c. Except as provided in section 8.58, the early childhood 13 programs endowment fund shall be considered a special account 14 for the purposes of section 8.53 in determining the cash 15 position of the general fund of the state for the payment of 16 state obligations.

7 Sec. 5. Section 8.58, Code 2001, is amended to read as 18 follows:

19 8.58 EXEMPTION FROM AUTOMATIC APPLICATION.

To the extent that moneys appropriated under section 8.57 or transferred to the early childhood programs endowment fund under section 8.55, subsection 2, do not result in moneys being credited to the general fund under-section-8.55, subsection-2, moneys appropriated under section 8.57 and for moneys contained in the cash reserve fund, rebuild Iowa for infrastructure fund, environment first fund, early childhood programs endowment fund, and Iowa economic emergency fund shall not be considered in the application of any formula, index, or other statutory triggering mechanism which would affect appropriations, payments, or taxation rates, contrary provisions of the Code notwithstanding.

32 To the extent that moneys appropriated under section 8.57 33 or transferred to the early childhood programs endowment fund 34 do not result in moneys being credited to the general fund 35 under section 8.55, subsection 2, moneys appropriated under

1 section 8.57 and moneys contained in the cash reserve fund, 2 rebuild Iowa infrastructure fund, environment first fund, 3 <u>early childhood programs endowment fund</u>, and Iowa economic 4 emergency fund shall not be considered by an arbitrator or in 5 negotiations under chapter 20.

## EXPLANATION

7 This bill creates an early childhood programs endowment 8 fund in the state treasury.

9 Moneys remaining at the close of the fiscal year, after 10 both the cash reserve fund and the Iowa economic emergency 11 fund have achieved their maximum balances, are credited to the 12 endowment fund.

13 Moneys in the endowment fund may be used for cash flow 14 purposes, provided the moneys are returned to the fund by the 15 end of the fiscal year. The interest and earnings on the fund 16 can only be used through an annual appropriation for purposes 17 of enhancing preschool and early education programs for young 18 children and their families. Otherwise, other moneys in the 19 fund are not subject to appropriation unless the appropriation 20 meets all of these conditions: the appropriation is the only 21 subject of the bill or joint resolution making the 22 appropriation, the reasons the appropriation is necessary are 23 stated, and at least three-fifths of the members of both 24 chambers of the general assembly vote for approval and the 25 bill or joint resolution is approved by the governor. The bill includes conforming changes in Code section 8.54 26 27 to strike the transfer of general fund ending balance moneys 28 back to the general fund once the cash reserve and Iowa 29 economic emergency funds have achieved their maximum balance, 30 and to provide in Code section 8.58, the endowment fund moneys 31 are not considered in any formula or other statutory 32 triggering mechanism or in collective bargaining negotiations 33 or arbitration.
