A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to the movement of bovine animals from livestock
2 markets, and making penalties applicable.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 172E.1, subsection 1, Code Supplement
2 2001, is amended by striking the subsection and inserting in
3 lieu thereof the following:

4 1. "Bovine animal" means an animal classified as bovine,
5 including domesticated breeds of cattle, bison, or a hybrid of
6 cattle and bison, regardless of the age or sex of the animal.

7 Sec. 2. Section 172E.2, subsection 1, Code Supplement
8 2001, is amended to read as follows:

9 1. If a livestock market accepts ~~dairy-cattle-upon-express~~
10 ~~written-condition-that-the-dairy-cattle-are-to-be-moved~~
11 directly bovine animal for sale to slaughter, the ~~dairy-cattle~~
12 bovine animal shall be segregated with other livestock to be
13 moved directly to slaughter until sold ~~to-a-packer~~. A person
14 shall not knowingly sell ~~the-dairy-cattle~~ the bovine animal to
15 a purchaser other than to a packer at the livestock market. A
16 person other than a packer shall not knowingly purchase the
17 ~~dairy-cattle~~ bovine animal at the livestock market.

18 EXPLANATION

19 During the General Assembly's regular session in 2001, it
20 enacted Senate File 209 (2001 Acts, regular session, chapter
21 101) that provided for the control of infectious or contagious
22 diseases in cattle and other animals. Part of that Act
23 established new Code chapter 165A regulating paratuberculosis
24 which primarily affects dairy cattle, and new Code chapter
25 172E requiring that if a livestock market accepts dairy cattle
26 upon express written condition that the dairy cattle are to be
27 moved directly to slaughter, the dairy cattle must be
28 segregated with other livestock to be moved directly to
29 slaughter until sold to a packer. Under both chapters, the
30 penalty for a violation is a civil penalty of at least \$100
31 but not more than \$1,000.

32 This bill amends provisions in Code chapter 172E, including
33 Code section 172E.2, by providing that if a livestock market
34 accepts a bovine animal (i.e., domesticated breeds of cattle,
35 bison, or hybrids) for sale to slaughter, the bovine animal

27 that the dairy cattle are to be moved directly to slaughter,

29 sold to a packer. This bill eliminates the requirement that
30 the condition be expressed in writing.

AN ACT
RELATING TO THE MOVEMENT OF DAIRY CATTLE FROM LIVESTOCK
MARKETS, AND MAKING PENALTIES APPLICABLE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 172E.2, subsection 1, Code Supplement 2001, is amended to read as follows:

1. If a livestock market accepts dairy cattle upon express written condition that the dairy cattle are to be moved directly to slaughter, the dairy cattle shall be segregated with other livestock to be moved directly to slaughter until sold to a packer. A person shall not knowingly sell the dairy cattle to a purchaser other than to a packer at the livestock
