Description

House File 2591 increases the fee for a resident hunting license from \$12.50 to \$17.00 beginning July 1, 2002, and ending June 30, 2007. The Bill specifies that a minimum of 60.0% of the revenues collected from the hunting fee increase will be used for the restoration of pheasant and quail wildlife.

Assumptions

- 1. The estimated number of resident hunting licenses sold each year is 200,000.
- 2. The fee increase is \$4.50 per license, generating approximately \$900,000 per year in revenue.
- 3. The Department will use at least \$540,000 for the restoration of pheasant and quail wildlife.
- 4. Remaining funds will be use to pay for retirement benefits of Fish and Wildlife Conservation Officers and for other fish and wildlife activities. This is estimated to be approximately \$360,000 per fiscal year.

Fiscal Impact

The fiscal impact of HF 2591 is an increase in revenue of \$900,000 to the Fish and Game Protection Fund for FY 2003 through FY 2007. Of that amount, 60.0% or \$540,000 will be allocated for the restoration of pheasant and quail wildlife.


