- 22 EXPLANATION
- 23 This bill amends Code section 514C.4, relating to mandated
- 24 insurance coverage for mammography. The bill adds required
- 25 coverage for physician-recommended mammograms every six months
- 26 for women with a family history of breast cancer. The bill
- 27 also deletes an outdated 1989 date reference in Code language
- 28 requiring the insurance commissioner to adopt administrative
- 29 rules to administer the Code section. The bill takes effect
- 30 July 1, 2002.

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
