## AN ACT

PERMITTING COOPERATIVE ASSOCIATIONS TO DEAL WITH NONMEMBERS,
TO USE FICTITIOUS NAMES, AND TO ISSUE MEMBERSHIPS WITHOUT

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 499.3, Code 2001, is amended to read as follows:

499.3 DEALING WITH NONMEMBERS.

A nonstock livestock shipping association shall not handle livestock of any nonmembers.

Any association <u>may restrict the amount of business done</u> with <u>nonmembers and</u> may limit its dealings or any class thereof to members only.

If permitted by the association's articles of incorporation, any eligible subscriber for common stock or membership may vote and be treated as a member, after making part payment of the amount, if any, required to be paid for the common stock or membership in cash, giving the subscriber's note for the balance, and satisfying any other requirement for the subscription as set forth in the articles. A subscription may be forfeited as provided in section 499.32.

Stock or a membership certificate shall not be issued until payment of the amount, if any, required to be paid for the stock or membership certificate is fully made. A subscriber shall not hold office until the subscriber's certificate has been issued.

Sec. 6. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance, takes effect upon enactment.
