- 1 Section 1. PRESCRIPTION DRUG PROGRAM -- APPROPRIATION.
- 2 There is appropriated from the general fund of the state to
- 3 the Iowa department of public health for the fiscal year

- 5 following amount, or so much thereof as is necessary, to be
- 6 used for the purpose designated:
- 7 To provide direct services to participants in the program
- 8 developed by the department as a result of the directive to

- 10 Act, 2001, H.R. 4577 to establish and operate a mercantile

- This bill appropriates \$5 million to the Iowa department of

- 29 of public health under a directive of the federal Consolidated
- 30 Appropriations Act, 2001. The bill defines "direct services"
