1 Section 1. CHILDHOOD LEAD POISONING PREVENTION PROGRAM --  
2 APPROPRIATION. There is appropriated from the general fund of  
3 the state to the Iowa department of public health for the  
4 fiscal year beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2002,  
5 the following amount, or so much thereof as is necessary, to  
6 be used for the purpose designated:

7 For expansion of the childhood lead poisoning prevention  
8 program established in section 135.101 to nine additional  
9 counties:

10 ..... \$ 153,000

11 It is the intent of the general assembly that the childhood  
12 lead poisoning prevention program be expanded, incrementally,  
13 in subsequent fiscal years with the goal of expanding the  
14 program to all counties by fiscal year 2004-2005.

15 EXPLANATION

16 This bill provides an appropriation of \$153,000 from the  
17 general fund of the state to the Iowa department of public  
18 health for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2001, and ending  
19 June 30, 2002, for the expansion of the childhood lead  
20 poisoning prevention program (CLPPP) to nine additional  
21 counties. The bill provides that it is the intent of the  
22 general assembly to expand the CLPPP, incrementally, during  
23 subsequent fiscal years with the goal of expanding the program  
24 to all counties by fiscal year 2005.
