 2 Code 2001, is amended to read as follows:
         The area education agencies shall, after determining
 4 the administrative costs associated with the implementation of
 5 medical assistance reimbursement for the eligible services, be
 6 permitted to retain up to twenty-five percent of the federal
 7 portion of the total amount reimbursed to pay for the
 8 administrative costs.
                          This limitation does not apply to
 9 medical assistance reimbursement for services provided by an
10 area education agency under part C of the federal Individuals
11 With Disabilities Education Act. Funds received under this
12 section shall not be considered or included as part of the
13 area education agencies' budgets when calculating funds that
14 are to be received by area education agencies during a fiscal
15 year.

                             EXPLANATION
      This bill provides that a cap of 25 percent applied to the

18 amount of federal medical assistance reimbursement that an
19 area education agency (AEA) may retain for the administrative
20 costs of implementing reimbursement for eligible services,
21 does not apply to medical assistance reimbursement for
22 services the AEA provides under the Infants and Toddlers with
23 Disabilities Program (part C) of the federal Individuals With
24 Disabilities Education Act.
