## A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to a limitation on mandatory overtime.
2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

14 2. "Employer" means the same as defined in 29 U.S.C. § 203
15 of the federal Fair Labor Standards Act of 1938.
16 3. "Overtime" means the hours worked in excess of forty
17 hours in a calendar week.
18 Sec. 2. NEW SECTION. 91D.3 MANDATORY OVERTIME

An employer shall not require an employee to work more than 21 eighty hours of overtime in any consecutive two-week period. 22 In addition, an employee shall not be required by the employer
23 to work any hours during one twenty-four-hour period each calendar week.

Sec. 3. IMPLEMENTATION OF ACT. Section 25B.2, subsection 3, shall not apply to this Act.

EXPLANATION
This bill places a limit on the number of mandatory hours that an employer can require of an employee to not more than 80 hours of overtime in any consecutive two-week period. The bill also requires that an employer grant employees one day of rest per week.

The bill also adds a definition section to the Code chapter 91D.

The bill may include a state mandate as defined in Code
S.F. $\qquad$ H.F. 425
l section 25B.3. The bill makes inapplicable Code section 2 25B.2, subsection 3, which would relieve a political 3 subdivision from complying with a state mandate if funding for 4 the cost of the state mandate is not provided or specified. 5 Therefore, political subdivisions are required to comply with 6 any state mandate included in the bill.
