A BILL FOR 1 An Act to appropriate additional state funds to replace losses in revenue by certain cities due to the exemption from property taxation of industrial machinery, computers, and equipment. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- NEW SECTION. 427B.19E ADDITIONAL ASSISTANCE Section 1. 1 2 FOR CERTAIN CITIES.
- 1. An additional assistance fund is created to provide
- 4 additional replacement moneys to cities that qualify under
- 5 this section. Beginning with the fiscal year beginning July
- 6 1, 2001, through the fiscal year ending June 30, 2006, there
- 7 is appropriated annually from the general fund of the state to
- 8 the department of revenue and finance, to be credited to the
- 9 additional assistance fund, an amount sufficient to pay
- 10 additional assistance claims under this section.
- 11 If the total assessed value of the property in a city
- 12 assessed under section 427B.17 as of January 1, 1994, and
- 13 reported by the county auditor pursuant to section 427B.19,
- 14 comprised eight percent or more of the total assessed value of
- 15 taxable property in the city as of January 1, 1994, as

- 31 **EXPLANATION**
- 32 This bill creates an additional assistance fund to provide
- 33 certain cities additional funds to replace property tax
- 34 revenues lost from the phaseout of property tax on industrial
- 35 machinery, computers, and equipment (M & E). To qualify for

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1 the additional assistance, a city must show that the city's M 2 & E assessed valuation as of January 1, 1994, comprised 8 3 percent or more of its total assessed valuation of taxable 4 property. A city must file a claim for additional funds with 5 the department of revenue and finance on or before September 6 1, 2001. Once a city is approved to receive additional funds, 7 it need not file another claim for subsequent years. 8 amount of additional assistance a city may receive is equal to 9 90 percent of the replacement claim paid to the city in fiscal 10 year 1996-1997. 11 The additional assistance provided from this fund is to be 12 provided for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2001, through 13 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2006. The bill provides that 14 additional assistance is in addition to the city's M & E 15 replacement moneys received. 16 17

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
