Section 1. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. 249A.20A HEALTH CARE FACILITIES
2 -- ACCOUNTING PRINCIPLES.

3 Health care facilities as defined in section 135C.1 4 reimbursed under the medical assistance program shall utilize 5 generally accepted accounting principles in maintaining the 6 financial records of the facility. However, notwithstanding 7 the required utilization of generally accepted accounting 8 principles under this section, the cost limitations and 9 allowances provisions established by rules adopted under the 10 medical assistance program and applicable to health care 11 facilities shall remain applicable to health care facilities. 12 This section shall apply to health care facility cost reports 13 received on or after July 1, 2001.

Sec. 2. EMERGENCY RULES -- EFFECTIVE DATE. The department for human services may adopt emergency rules under section 16 17A.4, subsection 2, and section 17A.5, subsection 2, 17 paragraph "b", to implement this Act, and the rules shall become effective immediately upon filing, unless the effective 9 date is delayed by the administrative rules review committee, 20 notwithstanding section 17A.4, subsection 5, and section 21 17A.8, subsection 9, or a later effective date is specified in 22 the rules. Any rules adopted in accordance with this section 23 shall not take effect before the rules are reviewed by the 24 administrative rules review committee. Any rules adopted in 25 accordance with the provisions of this section shall also be 26 published as notice of intended action as provided in section 27 17A.4.

28 Sec. 3. Section 2 of this Act, being deemed of immediate 29 importance, takes effect upon enactment.

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EXPLANATION

This bill requires health care facilities reimbursed under the medical assistance program (Medicaid) to utilize generally accepted accounting principles in maintaining their financial records. The bill provides that cost limitations and allowances established by rule of the department remain

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1 applicable to health care facilities. The bill directs the 2 department of human services to adopt rules to implement the 3 requirements of the bill. The bill authorizes the department 4 to adopt the rules under emergency rulemaking provisions. The 5 emergency rulemaking provision takes effect upon enactment.

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
