HOUSE FILE 458 FISCAL NOTE

The estimate for House File 458 is hereby submitted as a fiscal note pursuant to Joint Rule 17 and as a correctional impact statement pursuant to Section 2.56, Code of Iowa. Data used in developing this fiscal note and correctional impact statement are available from the Legislative Fiscal Bureau to members of the Legislature upon request.

House File 458 creates a new section under Chapter 802.2, Code of Iowa and extends the statute of limitations period for filing a criminal charge for incest from three to ten years. Incest is a Class D felony which is punishable by confinement for no more than five years and a fine of at least \$750 but not more than \$7,500. The Bill also provides that the statute of limitations shall be extended for filing a criminal charge for incest committed on or with a person under the age of 18, to ten years after the person reaches the age of 18.

ASSUMPTIONS

- 1. The analysis is based on information obtained from the Justice Data Warehouse, which included statewide court information. Conviction and penalty information is based on FY 2000 data.
- There were eight offenders convicted of incest in FY 2000.
- 3. There were two convictions under 709.15, Code of Iowa during FY 2000.
- 4. The marginal cost per day for State prisons is \$16 per offender. The average length of stay for Class D felons in the State prison system is 21.3 months.
- 5. The marginal cost per day for probation or parole is \$1.55 per offender. The average length of stay for street supervision is 29 months for a Class D felony.
- The median cost per case for Class D felonies is \$1,000 to defend.
- Court costs for a Class D felony range from approximately \$3,000 to \$5,100 per case.

CORRECTIONAL IMPACT

House File 342 will result in increased cases to the prisons and community-based corrections, however, due to insufficient information, an estimate cannot be provided.

FISCAL IMPACT

House File 342 will result in increased cases being filed with the court,

however, an actual estimate cannot be provided due to insufficient information. The approximate cost for one person convicted of incest under Chapter 802, Code of Iowa would be \$17,000.

EXTENDING THE STATUTE OF LIMITATIONS PERIOD FOR FILING A CRIMINAL CHARGE OF INCEST OR SEXUAL EXPLOITATION BY A COUNSELOR OR THERAPIST.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. 802.2A INCEST -- SEXUAL EXPLOITATION BY A COUNSELOR OR THERAPIST.

- 1. An information or indictment for incest under section 726.2 committed on or with a person who is under the age of eighteen shall be found within ten years after the person upon whom the offense is committed attains eighteen years of age. An information or indictment for any other incest shall be found within ten years after its commission.
- 2. An indictment or information for sexual exploitation by a counselor or therapist under section 709.15 committed on or with a person who is under the age of eighteen shall be found within ten years after the person upon whom the offense is committed attains eighteen years of age. An information or indictment for any other sexual exploitation shall be found within ten years of the date the victim was last treated by the counselor or therapist.
- Sec. 2. Section 802.3, Code 2001, is amended to read as follows:
